## POLICIES PET FRIENDLY BEACH HOUSE HOSTEL

In order to make the stay of your favorite companion and other guests a unique experience, we invite you to read the following rules and regulations:

1. Pets are allowed, as long as they are domestic animals (dogs or cats). In no case, animals such as reptiles, arachnids, birds, among other species prohibited by law, will be allowed to enter.

2. Pets will only be accepted if the guest is in a private room. Not applicable for shared rooms.

3. The Hostel accepts a maximum capacity of 4 pets per night.

4. Pets that do not comply with all the regulations (vaccination card) are not allowed to enter.

5. It is forbidden to use the crockery and glassware intended for our guests to feed your pet.

6. Bathing pets in the room showers is prohibited, as well as the use of towels.

7. Pets must be kept out of the room during the cleaning service.

8. To maintain a clean and pleasant space, avoid letting your pet relieve itself in the public areas of the Hostel.

9. Pick up and clean up your pet's solid and liquid waste, if any, inside the facilities and in the surroundings of the Hostel.

10. The guest is obliged and responsible for cleaning up pet waste. If your pet discards liquid or solid waste on carpets, beds, mattresses, sofas, decorative chairs or any other element of the Hostel, the cleaning of this shall be the responsibility of the owner and if it is not possible to clean it, the owner shall pay for the affected item.

11. This regulation applies from the first moment the pet enters the Hostel.

12. All damages caused by the pet on the Hostel premises shall be borne by the owner.

13. Please avoid bringing dogs that habitually bark too much or are aggressive towards people or other pets. Complaints from other guests will be taken with the utmost seriousness and it will be management's decision to terminate the housing contract.

14. Every dog or cat, adult or puppy, must enter on a leash held by the hand of its master or owner.

15. According to Law 746 of 2002, the breeds of potentially dangerous dogs that must be subjected to this regulation are: American Staffordshire Terrier, Bullmastiff, Doberman, Dogo Argentino, Dogo de Bordeaux, Fila Brasileiro, Neapolitan Mastiff, Bull Terrier, Pit Bull Terrier, American Pit Bull Terrier, de presa canario, Rottweiler, Staffordshire Terrier, Japanese Tosa and such new breeds or mixtures of breeds as the national government may determine. The dogs of this list may not be carried by minors in the streets or public spaces. Adult dogs may not be carried without a muzzle.





The dog must remain on a leash during their stay.

To ensure compliance with the policies, the Hostel requests a deposit of \$50.000 per pet, which will be returned at check-out, after checking that the room and the social areas of the Hostel are in good condition.
